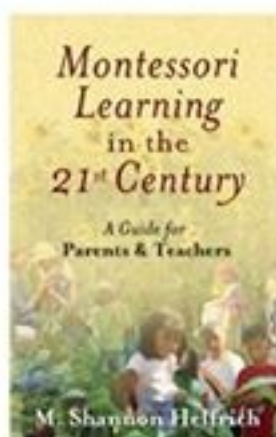




MONTESSORI LEARNING IN THE 21ST CENTURY
